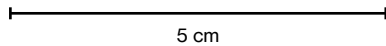


## RING SIZE GUIDE

**This guide is intended to help you find your ring size. Primarily we would recommend you to visit a local jewellery store or gold/silver smith to get your finger measured or to try out different rings to find what size fits you best. If used carefully, this guide will give you a good indication of what size will work for you.**

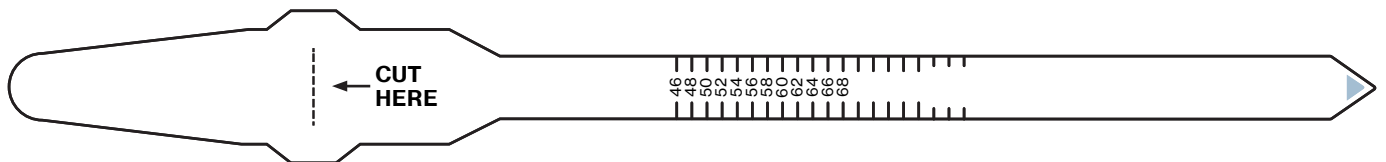
### STEP 1: CONFIRM PRINTED PAPER SIZE

1. Print this sheet. Make sure the "scale to fit" option is unchecked in the print settings dialogue.
2. Measure the line below with a ruler. If the line is exactly 5 cm long then you have printed it out correctly.



### STEP 2: MEASURE INSTRUCTIONS

1. Cut along the outline of the sizer. make a small slit on the dashed line next to the "cut here" text.  
**Tip :** to cut the dashed slit with scissors, fold the sizer over the length and cut along the dashed line.
2. Wrap the sizer around the intended finger with the numbers facing out.
3. Slide the pointed end of the sizer through the slit.
4. Pull tightly. The sizer must fit tightly over the finger to produce an accurate size.
5. The number that lines up at the slit represents the ring size for that finger.
